SUBJECT: Scholarship Opportunities for Paraprofessionals

General Information:

An Educational Trust Fund is established in the Agreement between the Denver Federation for Paraprofessionals and the Denver Public Schools. Interest earned from the \$300,000 Trust Fund is used to pay tuition for selected paraprofessionals enrolled in college education classes leading to certification as a teacher. (Article 22).

The scholarship is currently for six (6) hours per semester. Receiving a scholarship or financial aid from another source does not prevent a paraprofessional from applying.

Paraprofessionals who complete a teacher certification program will be considered for employment based on their qualifications, employment interview and the employment needs of the Denver Public Schools.

The Educational Trust Fund Committee is composed of an equal number of members of the Denver Federation for Paraprofessionals and Denver Public Schools Administrators. The Committee screens, interviews and selects scholarship recipients. The Committee's recommendations are subject to approval by the Superintendent.

Paraprofessionals may select a college or university of their choice, but will be compensated at the tuition rate established by Metropolitan State College. If there is a difference in rates, the paraprofessional is responsible for the difference in cost.

Application Process:

If you are interested in this program, please submit a completed application (attached) to: Jan Landry, Human Resources, Room 501, Administration Building by **February 25, 2000**.

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In addition to the application you must:

• include three (3) letters of recommendation, one of which must be from the building principal,

The information provided by the principal is extremely important in the selection process.

• include a one (1) page letter of intent expressing why you want to be a teacher in the Denver Public

Schools,

• attach official copies of transcripts if you have completed any college coursework, and

• attach a copy of your last two performance appraisals. (Last appraisal if you are in your second year

of employment)

The attached application may be copied.

Finalists will be interviewed in March, 2000.

Requirements:

Must possess a high school diploma or GED

• Must have completed a minimum of one (1) school year as a paraprofessional in the district

Must be employed as a paraprofessional for a minimum of three (3) hours per day. Preferably 50%

of the time should be in the instructional program.

• Must be able to enter the program in the summer of 2000

• Must show satisfactory performance as a paraprofessional on recent performance appraisals

• Must meet the admission requirements of the selected college or university and maintain a "C"

average or above

Must complete at least three college courses per school year

• Must be committed to three years of continued employment as a teacher with the district upon

completion of the program
